



GRANT GUIDELINES

What is Summertime Kids?

The SUMMERTIME KIDS PROGRAM (STK) is a mini-grant program for nonprofit agencies to provide safe, fun-filled activities for Richland County children during the summer months. Grant amounts range from \$300 - \$2,500.

Grant dollars must be used for direct programming. Regular staffing, operational costs or occupancy costs are *NOT* covered by this grant.

Who is Eligible?

Any 501(c)(3) public charity and government entities. Some Churches.

Who is NOT Eligible?

Churches serving only their own congregations. Vacation Bible School. Summer school.

Application Process:

- Applications must be on the most current application form that includes the Richland County Foundation logo.
- Proposals must be *received* in the Foundation office by 5:00 p.m. Friday, February 10
- Please note, the original plus 18 copies must be submitted.
Submit only the application form (front and back).
NO ATTACHMENTS accepted.

Notification of Awards: Grants to be announced in late March 2012.
