- 3) Pursuing a full-time undergraduate program at an accredited college or university
- 4) New applicants achieve a 2.5 GPA or above and returning recipients achieve at least 2.0 GPA

## What you need to do . . .

- Complete and sign enclosed application
- Include a copy of the **“Print Summary”** of your Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA

### **6 STEPS TO YOUR “PRINT SUMMARY”**

- [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- FAFSA Follow-up (3rd column): View and print your student aid report
- Select 2010-2011 school year
- Enter personal info (SS#, birthdate, etc.): Submit
- Select transaction you want: “Print Summary”
- Format (print): PDF

A **“Print Summary”** includes the following:

- EFC (estimated family contribution)
- adjusted gross income
- school year
- name of applicant

- A copy of an official high school or university transcript

## What you need to know . . .

- Scholarship award is for the upcoming academic school year (fall, winter, spring)
- Scholarship grant dollars will be sent directly to the college/university beginning the second week of August
- It is the student’s responsibility to notify us in a change in college or university attended
- A change in college/university choice after a scholarship is awarded could result in a change of amount or loss of award

**Note: This is not a recurring scholarship.  
You must re-apply each year.**
