



### **Grand & Ghoulish Ghosts: Ren Young Writers Workshop**

Be our guests, and allow the historic Renaissance Theatre to become the backdrop for students' imaginations! Using the theme of "Haunting the Ren," your students will be led through improvisation and theatre games, as well as a host of age-appropriate, customized activities which are designed to stimulate creative thinking. A tour of the theatre, complete with a ghost story or two (and, shhhh...a bit of the theatre's history in Mansfield), will culminate with participants collaborating to write their own versions of a Renaissance ghost story. Designed to align with the Common Core Standards for English Language Arts, your class will be encouraged to use the qualities and details which enhance any piece of writing. Whether the story is ghastly, gruesome, or just plain grand, there will be something for everyone when your workshop is done!
